RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL SALES, MARKETING, RULES AND REGULATIONS

BECOMING A DISTRIBUTOR:

Thank you for applying to become an marome tea Distributor. You will become a Distributor only when we marome tea South Africa, Ltd. Accept. your application and your Distributorship is entered into our records. The terms and conditions of our Agreement are found in this application, the general Sales and Marketing rules & regulation.

RULES OF CONDUCT:

Distributors must adhere to the Sales and Marketing rules & regulation.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

Distributors are required to maintain the confidentiality of Marome Tea trade secrets, formulas, and other confidential information, and must not use this information for any purpose other than their Marome Tea distributorship.

TRANSFER OF DISTRIBUTORSHIP:

Transferring a distributorship requires prior written consent from marome tea and cannot be used to circumvent the rules or the law.

BUSINESS OPERATIONS:

Distributors can recruit others and earn commissions and bonuses from Marome Tea, but they cannot earn money solely from recruiting or sponsoring individuals without also having them engage in business activities.

PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS:

Payment obligations are generally enforceable, but Marome Tea may not be held liable for failures to perform due to circumstances beyond their reasonable control.

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TERM/ DURATION :

The term of the Agreement will be one year from the date this application was accepted m, renewable annually, so long as you comply with the requirements. Marome tea may terminate the Agreement if it determines that you or others participating in your Distributorship have violated the Agreement.

SELF-EMPLOYED:

As a Distributor, you are a self-employed independent contractor deciding, among other things, your schedule, how much time you wish to devote to your business, your expenses, and methods of operation. As an independent contractor, you are not an employee, agent, franchisee, fiduciary, or beneficiary of Marome tea or any other Distributor. You acknowledge that as an independent contractor, you will have no rights or benefits that an employee of Marome tea may have nor will you make any claim to the contrary In conducting your Marome tea business. You will comply with any and all applicable laws and regulations, including without limitations, the need to obtain business registration, if required. Upon Marome tea's request, you will provide documents showing evidence of your compliance with such laws and regulations.
